

# Marvell<sup>®</sup> Brightlane<sup>™</sup> 88Q120xM MACsec integrated Automotive 100Base-T1 PHY

Integrated MACsec, Open Alliance TC10 and IEEE 802.3bw compliant Automotive Ethernet PHY

### **Overview**


The Marvell Brightlane<sup>™</sup> 88Q1200M/88Q1201M device is a single-pair Ethernet physical layer transceiver (PHY) that supports operation over unshielded twisted pair (UTP). The transceiver implements the Ethernet physical layer portion of 100BASE-T1 as defined by the IEEE 802.3bw standard.

The 88Q120xM has integrated MACsec that secures against the Layer 2 In-Vehicle Networking security threats. MACsec secures data exchange on a hop-by-hop basis and prevents attacks such as intrusion, man-in-the-middle, and replay attacks.

The 88Q120xM is manufactured using a standard digital CMOS process and contains all the active circuitry required to implement the physical layer functions to transmit and receive data on a single balanced twisted pair. The device family supports reduced pin count GMII (RGMII) and SGMII for direct connection to a MAC/switch port.

The device integrates media dependent interface (MDI) termination resistors into the PHY. This resistor integration simplifies board layout and reduces board cost by reducing the number of external components. The device has a voltage regulator to generate all required voltages. The device can run off a single 3.3V supply. The device supports 1.8V, 2.5V, and 3.3V LVCMOS I/O standards.

The device uses advanced mixed-signal processing to perform equalization, echo and crosstalk cancellation, data recovery, and error correction at a data rate of 100 Mbps. The device achieves robust performance and exceeds electromagnetic interference (EMI) requirements in noisy environments with very low power dissipation.
